ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be received on or before the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper fees and submitted on an Official CKC entry form. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
2. **Please type or print clearly.** Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary (or Entry Service) is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Moving class dogs to specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
3. **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and Handlers, please note that **full name and address of owners MUST** be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. **(Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)**
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made. **Please review email confirmations so corrections may be made prior to closing date to avoid disappointment.** It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries before the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries. **Until the closing date any changes to your entry can be made via The Entry Line, after the closing date please contact the Show Secretary.**
5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time.
6. Only dogs entered in the Shows may enter the venue. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Service Dogs are welcome
7. Effective January 1, 2024, The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s). Exhibitors can verify the results at the event, watch for unofficial results to be posted on Canuck Dogs, or review the official results on your CKC portal where dogs are listed. For corrections of unofficial results posted on the Canuck Dogs website, please go to the Contact page on Canuck Dogs, select Results Correction and complete the form. For CKC Official Results please e-mail information@ckc.ca with the subject line of Results Correction.

Refund Policy - Covid & Otherwise: If, due to Covid, these Shows are not able to be held: refunds will be issued to exhibitors - MINUS any costs incurred by the HKC. Entry Line WILL NOT REFUND SERVICE FEES. If because of an act of God, riot or civil disobedience, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations or decree (other than Covid related), or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the HKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). **Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.**

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab call TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.**

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership to CKC, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicated your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. Please forward your request to:

OBEDIENCE TRIAL OFFICIAL CLASSES: The following CKC official classes will be provided: Pre-Novice, Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B. UNOFFICIAL CLASS - Wild Card

RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL OFFICIAL CLASSES: The following CKC official classes will be provided: Novice A, Novice B, Intermediate, Advanced A, Advanced B, Excellent A, Excellent B, Master. UNOFFICIAL CLASS - Team Rally will be offered

Please ensure jump heights are indicated on entry form for Advanced & Excellent.

Rally Team Classes

Eligibility for Team classes shall be the same as that listed for the obedience Team class, except that the class is open to any four dogs that have earned a title of RN or higher. Clubs may offer any of these classes: Rally Novice, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced, Rally Excellent and/or Rally Master.

Each team member will run the course individually, with the team time running continuously. The judge will give the first member of the team the "Forward" command from the Start sign. Each subsequent dog and handler will start when the previous dog and handler pass the Finish sign, without any additional command of "Forward" by the judge. Timing for each team will begin when the judge commands "Forward" to the first handler in the team and will stop when the fourth handler and dog pass the finish line.

If jumps are required, the height will be based on the height of the smallest dog on each competing team.

There will be no Sit Stay (Sign #298) or Stand Stay (Sign #398) included if the class is offered at the Excellent or Master level.

Scores will be based on a possible score of 400 points for each team, with ties being broken by time. Each dog and handler will be scored as in official classes. A qualifying score is 280 points or more except in the Master class, where 320 or more points is required.

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW, OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C. or on the C.K.C. website

Exhibitors entering both Obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Halifax Kennel Club will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs or exhibitors.
2. The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these Shows.
3. The Halifax Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
4. No Public Catalogue will be available. Know your numbers when picking up armbands.
5. Please Do Not leave personal belongings at ringside.
6. Please Do Not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc behind. Dispose of these items in the garbage bins provided.
7. Please Clean Up after your dogs.
