COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Province of Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) COVID-19 regulations will be followed. COVID-19 Related changes and temporary rule changes are detailed below.

- ALL competitors will be required to sign a waiver form and must turn waiver in at venue upon arrival, before competing. The Waiver is available on DogShow.ca.
- Masks are mandatory in all areas of the trial precinct face shields alone are NOT sufficient.
- There will be no spectators allowed at the rings.
- There will be no food services provided on-site at the Trial
- There will be no dogs allowed as Exhibition Only or In Transit
- *Catalogues will be provided by Email only (Saturday AM)
- There will be no public catalogue provided, so please be prepared with all of the entry information of your dog should you need to move up or change your entry.

COVID-19 CKC OBEDIENCE TRIAL ALLOWABLE CHANGES

- Handler will place their leash, dumbbells etc. in a designated spot and pick up after their run. The ring steward will NOT bring your leash to you. Your dog must leave the ring on-leash and under control.
- Utility handlers please bring tongs as you may be required to handle your own articles. Stewards will wear new disposable gloves if handling scent articles and bag.
- Qualifying Rosettes, ribbons and score sheets will be left on a table for handlers to pick up if they wish at end of their class. No ribbon/rosette presentations in the ring.
- Special prizes will be verified by Trial Chair and will be placed out at time of award in specified location.
- Pylons will be used for Figure 8 posts at all levels
- Group Stays dogs will be placed a minimum of 8 feet apart for all levels. A dog that fails to qualify in the Individual Exercises will not be eligible to compete in the Group Exercise.
- NOTE Jump Heights for dogs will be according to their correct height at the withers or for accepted veteran heights. There will be no reduced heights incorporated into these trials.
- Large classes may be broken up into groups and you will be invited in as others leave to accommodate the Group Exercises.

COVID-19 INFORMATION – SUBJECT TO CHANGE

All Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) regulations will be followed.

- If you are exhibiting ANY symptoms of COVID-19, please do not attend the trials.
- Any handler unable to attend these trials due to exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms after entries close will receive a credit to any future CKC event hosted by Hub City Kennel and Obedience Club. Credits will expire after one year.
- MASKS will be mandatory at all times for all competitors on the precincts of the trial.
- New restrictions may be applied at time of event according to SHA regulations.
- ONLY handlers entered in the specific class being judged will be allowed into the building and we ask that you space yourselves at least 10 feet apart.
- There will be temporary benching spots for dogs/crates during class and vacated after class to make space for exhibitors in following classes.
