Entries close at 8:00 p.m., Wednesday April 27, 2022, or when entry limit is reached, whichever occurs earlier.

## LIMITED ENTRY

Entry in the obedience trials will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. Entry in the rally obedience trials will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 dogs per hour less time for walk-throughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. **Total time allotted for judging will be 9 hours to be divided between obedience and rally based on the entries received**. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

## CATALOGUES

Catalogues are available on a PRE-ORDER basis. Those who wish to pre-order at the price of \$3.00 may do so by indicating this on the entry form. A limited number of catalogues will be available for sale at the trials for a price of \$5.00.

## **ENTRY INFORMATION**

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
- 2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
- 3. Telephone/fax/online entries are accepted by The Entry Line at 1-800-293-2935; (fax) 519-754-0796, www.entryline.com, or at www.dogshow.ca.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 5. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited.
- 6. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.
- 7. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 8. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE FRIDAY, APRIL 27, 2022 AT 8:00 pm, OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- 9. Identification cards and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented to the Trial Secretary upon arrival at the trial.
- 10. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.

## **BITCHES IN SEASON**

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

## **U.S.A. EXHIBITORS**

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry, will be accepted.

Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured.

Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks.

## UNOFFICIAL CLASSES Obedience Trial 157

Dogs entered in an Unofficial Class must be entered in a Regular Class (Obedience for Unofficial Obedience Classes, Rally for Unofficial Rally Classes), or for Exhibition Only.

#### **OBEDIENCE**

**Brace Class** – is open to any 2 dogs that have earned the title of CD or higher. The owner or any other person may handle the dogs. The same handler must handle each brace in all 6 exercises, unless he has 2 or more braces, entered, in which case, there must be an additional handler for each brace for the group exercises. This class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class, with the 2 dogs hitched together with a brace chain or coupling.

**Veterans Class** – is open to any dog that has earned the title of CD or higher, and is at least 7 years old on the day of the trial. The owner or any other person may handle the dog. The same handler must handle the dog in all 6 exercises, unless he has 2 or more Veterans entered, in which case, there must be an additional handler for each dog for the group exercises. The class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice Class.

## JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior Handling will be held between obedience trials 155 and 156

### Entries will be taken at the trial secretary's desk.

**Classes Offered:** Junior Obedience Pre-Novice, Intermediate Obedience Pre-Novice, Senior Obedience Pre-Novice, Junior Obedience Novice, Intermediate Obedience Novice, Senior Obedience Novice, Junior Obedience Open, Intermediate Obedience Open, Senior Obedience Open. Complete descriptions of the requirements for each class can be found in the CKC Junior Handling Rules and Regulations (Conformation and Obedience).

Held under CKC Rules. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the trial on that day. The Labrador Owners Club will be offering a rosette and prize for the Best Overall Junior Handler.

**Junior Handling Numbers:** Effective January 1, 2016 – Section 3.4.1 "All Junior Handlers except for Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. The Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Labrador Owners Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. A dog shall not be touched without permission of the owner or agent.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- 4. The trial precincts shall be the training hall (if public health measures allow) and grounds at Companion Dog training.

## **NEW – CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

- 1. A non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian nonmember of CKC.
- 2. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- 3. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- 4. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and are not applicable to CKC members.

#### **OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

#### MASTER OBEDIENCE TRIAL CHAMPION (MOTCH)

Section 14.3.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters MOTCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 14.3.2 Points for this title may only be accumulated after the completion of the OTCH title.

Section 14.3.3 Points may be accumulated simultaneously with credits toward both the OTCHX and MOTCH titles. However, the MOTCH title will not be awarded until completion of the OTCHX title.

Section 14.3.4 One High in Class placement is required in either of the Open B classes or the Utility B class but no minimum score is required.

Section 14.3.5 A dog must acquire a total of 40 points to earn a MOTCH title. A minimum of 15 points must be obtained from either of the Open B classes and the Utility B class. The remaining 10 points can be obtained from either class.

#### RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 17.7 of the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

#### **RALLY CHAMPION (RCH)**

Section 16.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters RCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 16.2 A dog may begin earning points toward the RCH title as soon as the Rally Master (RM) title requirements have been completed.

Section 16.3 The RCH title will be awarded to dogs that have successfully earned a minimum of 100 points total from competing in both the Excellent B and Master classes in the same trial.

- (a) 50 points must come from the Rally Excellent B class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
- (b) 50 points must come from the Rally Master class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.

Section 16.4 A qualifying score must be earned in both the Excellent B class and the Master class in the same trial on five (5) different occasions under at least five (5) different judges

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Trial and Rally obedience Trial Rules and Regulations and it shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an Obedience Trial or Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Chapter 20 – Section 20.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations and Chapter 17 – Section 17.1of the Rally obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.

Turn right onto Bishop St., take the first exit at the next roundabout onto Franklin Blvd. Turn right onto Turnbull Court and left into the parking lot. Park in front of units 3& 4.

**From London**: Exit the 401 at Franklin Blvd. and go south (you can only go south). Travel straight through the first roundabout, remaining on Franklin Blvd. At the second roundabout take the third exit onto Sheldon Dr. and turn immediately into the first driveway on the right. Continue around the first building and come down a small hill into the second parking lot. Park in front of units 3 & 4
