Classifications

In all breeds, recognized by the C.K.C., the following classes will be provided for, divided by sex.

Junior Puppy 6 Months and under 9 Months on day of show.
Senior Puppy 9 Months and under 12 Months on day of show.
12 – 18 Months 12 Months and under 18 Months on day of show.

Canadian Bred Dogs born in Canada

(Champions of any country excluded)

Bred by Exhibitor Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder

Open For all dogs

Specials Only For Canadian Champions

Exhibition Only For all dogs over 6 Months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club

Note: In all breeds, where classes are divided by colour, weight, or coat, indicate clearly in the class

division on the entry forms.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN). TCNs can be obtained: • Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online); • By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or • By contacting the Shows & Trials Division Toll Free: 1-855-364-7252. Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$64.00 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

Non-Member Participation Fee

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$170.00 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-members will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

***** JUNIOR HANDLING *****

Regular Junior handling will be held Saturday June7th.

Juniors MUST pre-enter. Use the special JH entry form and submit directly to Show Secretary by mail or Drop Box at CCC.

There is no fee.

Dogs may be neutered/spayed, but must be entered in a regular class at the show or in Exhibition Only

Itzy Bitzy Junior handling class (unofficial class for kids under 4 years of age)

The club will supply a stuffed dog toy and leash, and all the kids will enter the ring for fun mock judging.

CKC Junior Handling rules apply. Dogs must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only.

All breed sweepstakes is open to all breeds. Dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only to show. Classes are divided by sex and are:

Baby Puppy: 4-6 Months Junior Puppy: 6-9 Months Senior Puppy: 9-12 Months Juvenile: 12-18 Months

1st in class: 30% of entries for that class 2nd in class: 20% of entries for that class 3rd in class: 15% of entries for that class 4th in class: 10% of entries for that class

Best of Sweepstakes: Rosette

Best Puppy in Sweepstakes: Rosette

25% of total fees collected will be retained by the club to defray costs.

*****BABY PUPPY CLASS****

The Baby Puppy Class is for dogs 4 months and under 6 months on the day of the show. Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy Class do not compete for points.

Puppies entered in this class will participate & compete for Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group and Best Baby Puppy in Show.

Baby puppies must be CKC registered or have a TCN (no charge)

NB...There is NO LISTING FEE for Baby Puppies who are not yet registered!!!!!

Veteran Class

Veteran Class is an optional class, dogs must be 7 years of age and older on the day of the show. Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered. The rewards for this class are:

Best Veteran Dog and Best Veteran Bitch

Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show

Points Are Not Awarded to Incorrect or Incomplete Entries

- When a dog is co-owned, the names of all owners must appear on the entry form.
- Enter the dog under its registered name, not its call name or another dog's name. The only exception is with listed
 dogs where the name may change upon registration.
- A foreign dog registered in another country must be entered under its registered name in the country of origin.
- All entry forms must be legible type or print the information.
- NEW RULE: Section 8.2.5 Dog Show Rules: Effective Jan 1/06, an error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Chapter 20: Champions and Championship Points

Section 1. A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Rules shall be accredited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Section 4. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition as provided in Chapter 4, Section 8(j) of these Rules shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

Fee must accompany entry. Make all cheques/money orders payable to Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club. A charge of \$20.00 will be charged for a NSF cheque, or refused credit card. Attention USA Exhibitors: US exhibitors may pay by personal cheque on a US Bank, or by US Money Order in US funds. NB: Because of the unpredictable fluctuation in exchange rates, cheques and money orders on US banks must be "at par". Credit card charges on US banks are automatically adjusted by the credit card company on the day the charge is submitted. An administration processing fee of 10% of total entry will be applied if using visa or mastercard.

General Information

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the Shows and Specialty Shows, which shall be governed by the Canadian Kennel Club Rules.

Print your entries carefully, Include your complete address. Errors made on entries by exhibitors, or their agent must stand regardless of how or by whom entries were made.

No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee. No refund of entry fees will be made if it is impossible to open or complete any show because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of The Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club.

Entry fees will not be refunded should the dog be absent, sick, lame, in season, or excused by a Veterinarian, the Judge, or the Show Superintendent.

The Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to Canadian Kennel Club Rules.

Dogs must be ready for judging; individual dogs will not be called. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a Breed or Group. Dogs not entered in the Show are not allowed on the show grounds.

Exercise areas must be used. The Show Committee will take all precautions and use all methods to keep the building and surrounding area as clean as possible. Exhibitors are expected to do their part as well, please DO NOT let your dogs urinate onto the building, structures, garbage cans, etc.

The Thunder Bay Kennel & Training Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors shall exercise control and restraint over their children while attending

The show premises will be open no later than two hours before the scheduled judging time.

The precinct of the Show is the Pavilion, tent area, parking lot and rec centre building.

Free grooming/set up for pop up tents will be available in the adjacent field, generators are welcome and selection is first come/first served.
