<u>Note:</u> Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

**Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs** will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes. Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Brace Class - shall be for 2 dogs of the same breed.

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best Altered of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

#### **SWEEPSTAKES**

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 3 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. To enter the puppy class dogs must be entered in Exhibition Only. There will be 10 classes in all, divided by sex

3-6 Mo. Class	for dogs at least 3 months of age up to but not including 6 months.
6-9 Mo. Class	for dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.
9-12 Mo Class	for dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.
12-15 Open	for dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 15 months.
15-18 Open	for dogs at least 15 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette & trophy will be awarded to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

#### VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes. Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be 6 classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years	for dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years.
9-11 years	for dogs at least 9 years of age up to but not including 11 years.
11 years plus	for dogs at least 11 years of age.

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the prize money distributed as follows:

Best In Sweepstakes	15% of total prize money
Best Opposite in Sweepstakes	10% of total prize money
First in each class	25% of entry fees for that class

The remainder will be retained by the club for administrative costs

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- The Building will open at 6:30am each day. On Friday, the Building will be open from 4:00pm until 10:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- All rules and regulations pertaining to the Halifax Kennel Club show are applicable to this show.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging and may be removed from the building after their breed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The BdFCC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is eforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The BdFCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the doos and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the BdFCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and it's entrances.
