Our Judges

Linda Scanion - All Regular, Non-Regular for all breeds

Linda began in AKC Conformation as a teenager with Australian Terriers. She bred/owned/handled the first triple titled Aussie (Conformation, Obedience, Earth Dog). Saluki's entered her life in 1972 and from a small breeding program there have been multiple Champions in the ring and field, including Specialty winners, dual titlists, tracking and obedience titled dogs. Linda was the first person to earn the AKC UD on a Saluki (2 individuals) and also earned multiple Will Judy/Dog World Awards and all breed Highs in Trial in the US and Canada.

Initially, Linda was approved to judge Salukis and Australian Terriers and currently judges BIS, Hound and Herding Groups in the US, all levels of obedience and rally, lure coursing and junior showmanship. She is the only AKC judge fully approved for this combination of events. She has judged multiple specialties including having been twice selected by her peers to judge Conformation at the National Saluki Specialty. Out of country assignments include Australia, Belgium, Canada, China, England, Germany, Finland, New Zealand and Sweden, with multiple return trips to most of these countries.

Her other passions in life include her 2 adult sons, her husband of over 60 years and international travel.

I've been teaching conformation handling classes for 27 years now and was also an all-breed handler. I have bred collies (rough and smooth) under the Tamaron prefix for 37 years and whippets under the Counterpoint prefix for 17 years.

My collies and whippets have both been very successful in the show ring. My collies have won the Canadian National (both a rough and a smooth) and I have won 2 Best in Shows and over 65 group wins and placements on my heart dog, smooth collie Kennedy.

Counterpoint Whippets have had amazing success but the most noteworthy was my solid red brindle bitch Jill who amassed 13 all-breed Best in Show wins, 100's of groups wins and placements and won the National twice! I am very excited and honored to be judging your beautiful puppies.

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs in the Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes at this Specialty. Puppies aged 4-6 months may enter Sweepstakes from Exhibition Only.

The following classes will be offered (divided by sex):



CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not
	handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
FIELD CLASS	Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging with winners of each sex competing for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES will be judged after the Regular classes



FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events will no longer require a CKC registration number **but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number**. An ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the *Animal Pedigree Act* but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own ERN number. A CKC ERN registration form and ERN fee details can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca To obtain an ERN, mail or fax the Canadian Kennel Club the ERN form with a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate plus a certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.**

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may EITHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that the CKC is aware of the dogs involved.

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you! The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by **telephone but written or electronic notification must be_received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time**. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show

Kindly note that the Alberta Lure Coursing Association (ALCA), and/or its agents, may take candid photos, win photos, or videos of the specialty show, including but not limited to, images of the exhibitors and their dogs. Such images may be published by ALCA in print or on the ALCA web-site or Facebook page without your consent. By entering the ALCA specialty show, you waive all rights to such images and agree that ALCA may use them for its promotional or educational purposes, and without notice or compensation to you.

LOSS WAIVER

By entering a dog at this show, the owner(s) of the dog and any agent acting on behalf of the owner(s) of the entered dog, agree that the Alberta Lure Coursing Association has the right to refuse the dog's entry for cause, in accordance with the CKC rules and regulations. In consideration of the acceptance of the dog's entry, the owner (or the agent acting on behalf of the owner(s), agrees to hold the Alberta Lure Coursing Association its members, directors, officers and agents, and the judge of this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may allegedly be caused directly, or indirectly, to any person or thing by the act of the dog entered, while in or about the event grounds, The owner(s) and any agent acting on behalf of the owner(s), personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and by entering a dog, the owner(s) further agrees to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to the dog entered in this show.

The owner(s) and any agent acting on behalf of the owner(s) of the entered dog further agree to assume the sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person(s), on account of damage to property arising out of, or as a consequence, of participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused, or may be alleged to have been caused, by negligence of the aforementioned Alberta Lure Coursing Association, its members, directors, officers, or any employees, or agents.

- 5. We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SCHEDULE

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 -5	6-9	10-12	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.
