COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

WE WILL BE FOLLOWING PROVINCIAL AND LOCAL COVID-19 GUIDELINES Please refer to https://www.alberta.ca/ for the latest Provincial restrictions and guidelines pertaining to outdoor sports activities.

Any person found to be willfully disregarding these precautions will be ordered to leave the property, with no refund of any entry fees.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING/MASKS:

The Provincial physical distancing guideline of maintaining a minimum of 6 feet or 2 meters distance from others whenever possible must be adhered to at these events by volunteers and participants. We are asking that you stay in or near your vehicle except when running or exercising a dog. All participants will wear facial coverings over nose and mouth when not able to maintain social distancing such as dog inspections, handlers' meetings, when releasing/catching dogs at start/finish line.

Volunteers will wear facial coverings when in close contact with others.

Participants must provide their own mask or other suitable face covering.

We ask that you park 6 feet away from each other.

If you have a medical reason for not being able to wear a mask, we kindly ask you to consider your health and to reconsider entering and wait for a time when we are able to lift mask restrictions.

RUNNING THE EVENT:

Roll Call/Inspection will be done at everyone's car, instead of at the normal gathering area. The roll call committee will wear facial coverings at this time. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.

Huntmaster(s) will stand 6 feet from the dogs and will wear masks.

Do not crowd at the secretary's area for run information or for results posting. There will be a Paddock Master calling dogs to the line. Be aware of when it is your turn.

CLEANLINESS:

Sanitizer will be available in the gathering area. Bring your own hand sanitizer to use before and after touching your mask, as well as any other incidences of touching objects with contamination potential.

Porta Potty – Please use the provided spray to sanitize the area after you use it, prop the door open for airflow when not in use. If you have a trailer/RV, please use your own toilet facilities.

FOOD:

To comply with health and safety guidelines related to COVID-19, there will be no food or water provided on site. Participants will need to bring their own food/refreshments. Remember to provide for your dog as well.

WELLNESS:

If on the days leading up to, or the day of these events you or any member of your household are exhibiting any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19, please refrain from attending these events. Entry withdrawals due to illness will be refunded in full.

COVID REFUND POLICY: In the event that provincial regulations change and force the cancellation of these events prior to the day of the event, entry fees will be refunded (less applicable processing fees).

Though we greatly appreciate offers of help, designated club members will be sole handlers of pulleys/tie downs and any other equipment in use at the event.

Practice social distancing the best you can. Please act responsibly

Reminder these are HIGH INTENSITY SPORTS!!!

There will be **ZERO** tolerance for the use of flexi leads pinch/prong or shock collars!

A tie out is **NOT** considered a suitable manner to secure your dog

NO loose dogs on the field at any time

If your dog needs to be off leash, for any reason, *please* go up to the road and walk along it.

Off leash training of your dog is **NOT** permitted.

Any dog off leash when it is not their turn running will be **EXCUSED** for the day.

** Note- this does not include an accidental escapee.

Additional Information

- Dogs will be run once per event.
- Lame dogs or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they shall be refunded their entry and not allowed to run.
 Additionally, the field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- o Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion.

No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed.

- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after the last test.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- o A veterinary clinic is within easy access from the field.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs.
- Do not stuff plastic bags down holes, or put in port-a-potties

You make it you take it, there will be no trash receptacles on site.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Sprinter Rule books are available from the Canadian Kennel Club (updated January 2020).
- The Event Chairman will be in full charge of the events which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Entries made through Dogshow.ca will be acknowledged by email, with receipt. A running order will be published for start times.
- "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the event secretary by October 1st 2020 to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

(Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules). To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Event Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail. Please do not send entries by Registered Mail.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered nonpayment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

The owner of a dog entered in this event is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy funds. Thank you!

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event.



SPRINTER

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

SPRINTER EVENT participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.
- have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN) (<u>required</u> for any dog without one of numbers listed above)

Sprinters are an athletic pursuit that requires your dog to be in very good condition. Your dog relies on you to ensure this. Females in season may not compete.

If in the opinion of the Test Committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or a female in season, it shall not be allowed to compete, and the entry fees shall be refunded.

YOUR TEAM

CKC rules state that 'It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed.

You must have a catcher and releaser

EARNING POINTS

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH). A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- (a) 18" or greater handicap is 1.25.
- (b) 12" up to less than 18" handicap is 1.5.
- (c) Below 12" handicap is 2.0.

Points - KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example 20 KPH \times 1.5 = 30 points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

Please be sure to enter the correct height category; If you are unsure of your dog's height please measure them

AWARDS AND TITLES

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a score.

The titles dogs may earn in Sprinter events are;

Novice Sprinter (NS) awarded to a dog that earns 150 points

Sprinter (S) awarded to a dog that earns 500 points

Advanced Sprinter (AS) awarded to a dog that earns 1000 points

Sprinter Excellent (SX) awarded to a dog that earns 1500 points

Sprinter Excellent 2 (SX2) awarded to a dog that earns 2000 points.

For each additional 500 points the dog may add a higher number after the SX (SX3, SX4, etc.)

ATTENTION: CANADIAN EXHIBITORS

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. **The fee is \$64.00 + 5% GST.**
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

This fee does not have to be paid before entering these events.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan 1, 1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$64.00 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.</u>

• Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog.

NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

From the North: QE Hwy #2 South to Stoney Trial Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trial East to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (exit 68) Go East on Country Hills Blvd (Hwy # 564) for 17.2 km to Hwy #9. South on Hwy #9 3.2 km (2 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). East 1.6 km (1 mile) to Rge Rd 271. Right turn-South to first acreage.

From the South: QE Hwy #2 North to Stoney Trail Exit 234A. Exit East (right) on Stoney Trail and follow to Hwy #22X East Exit 96. Take Hwy #22X East to Langdon Corner (Rge Rd 272). Signage for Boulder Creek Golf Course. North on Rge Rd 272 to 4-way Stop at Langdon. Continue North (now on Hwy 797) to Hwy #1. Cross Hwy #1 onto Hwy #9. North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North.

<u>From the West:</u> Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Stoney Trail Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trail to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (exit 68). At this point, follow directions from North.

From the East: Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #9. Turn Right on Hwy #9 and go North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North.

If your GPS wants you to take Twp Rd 250 ignore it and take Twp Rd 252.
