**PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs MUST be ready for testing and are to be judged in catalogue order with the exception of bitches in season. Judges will not hold up the test waiting for entrants and any undue delays will be considered as withdrawal from further exercises. A lunch break will be scheduled at the Judges discretion.

**DDX Entrants:** Please have your dogs backpack packed and ready for weighing at check in. Per CKC regulations, "The dog must carry a 2 day supply of dog food (no tins). Backpacks should include lightweight items which might be required for a 2 to 3 day trip. Packs are to be adequately sized to allow for the ability to carry approx. one-sixth (1/6) of the dog's weight to a maximum of 11.3 kilograms (25 lbs)."

**Bitches in Season:** Entrants must contact the Test Secretary as soon as possible if their bitch comes into season prior to this test. Bitches in season may compete; however, they shall be judged after all other dogs competing have been tested. Prior to competing, they shall be confined away from the test site.

**Refreshments & Lunch:** Lunch will be provided for a cost of \$5 per person. Funds raised will go towards draft test fundraising.

**Washrooms:** Entrants will have access to onsite washrooms in house

**Weather:** Do not forget that weather in this region, this time of year can be very unpredictable so be prepared for anything! Dress in layers for warmth and be sure to bring your rain gear. This is an outdoor event!

**Directions to the Test Site:**

From Route 1 USA or NS, Moncton, or Saint John take Exit #114 to Route 7 Fredericton/Grand Bay-Westfield. Follow for about 15 minutes until you reach exit #80. Turn right off the ramp and continue down the hill to the flashing light. Go straight through over the bridge/causeway. Take the first road on your left- CAMPBELL Road. Site is exactly 3.5 km in on the left, cedar home 611 Campbell Road.

Coming from Fredericton, take Route 7 to Exit #80, turn left off the ramp and follow directions above after coming down the hill to the flashing light.
