## CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

***The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to [www.ckc.ca](http://www.ckc.ca) under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is a fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles***

## ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

## To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Nonresidents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. -Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension. ## Temporary Competition Number (TCN) – Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN. TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club we will be unable to accept, cancel or substitute an entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing date. Moving class dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
2. All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be sent as soon as possible after entries close.
3. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receiving of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
5. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged.
7. The New Brunswick Kennel Club, its officers and associates will use due care & diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, and it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
8. The Dog Show will be open to the general public.
9. There will be no indoor grooming area, and power **IS NOT** supplied. You must be self-sufficient (portable generators).
10. A tent will be provided near the ring entrances. No cover will be provided for individuals in case of inclement weather.
11. Only Exhibitors who are having the breeds within their group judged are permitted to have crates, etc. under the tent until all the breeds in that group are judged.
12. The Show Superintendent Jim Arsenault (cell 285-1811) is in charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
13. The precincts of the show will start inside the Gate beside the Lorneville Community Centre to the furthest fence of the ball field.
14. The **NBKC** will not be responsible for equipment left behind at the site or on site overnight.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

## PRIZES

Suitable Prizes & Rosettes will be offered for BIS, RBIS, BPIS, BBPIS BVIS.

Rosettes will be awarded to Group 1<sup>st</sup> through Group 4<sup>th</sup>, BPIG, BBPIG, BVIG.

A small Canadian token will be given to all Exhibitors entered in the Canadian Bred class.

## CATALOGUE

Catalogues are available on a **"pre-order basis" ONLY** at \$12.00 per copy. Pre-ordered catalogues must be paid for at time of ordering (with entry). **Catalogues will not be mailed to absent exhibitors.**

## CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

**SECTION 1:** A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

**SECTION 2:** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6 -9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

## GRAND CHAMPION POINTS

**15.2 Grand Champion (GCh)** 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. 15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh.

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

(d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

**15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)** The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

**15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)** The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (17-09-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) (07-04-21) (05-06-20) (05-06-20) 5354 (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

**15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold: (GChG)** The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

**15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)** 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles

15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

**NOTE:** Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

#### **ALTERED CHAMPION AND ALTERED POINTS**

**Section 13.8.1** Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

**Section 15.1.12** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion [Alt] and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

#### **PLEASE NOTE: ERRORS IN RESULTS**

**Section 9.9 (Amended)** – Effective January 1, 2024 - The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).

#### **HEALTH REMINDERS**

No Dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

- Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
- Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
- Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

At events where judges will be checking bites, judges should be encouraged to have the exhibitors show the bite. If the judge insists on checking bites themselves, they are expected to use hand sanitizer or soap and water in between each exhibit. Please ensure that sanitizer wipes and bottles of hand sanitizer are available at all times at events.

**From Fredericton:** Take Hwy NB-7 S towards Saint John – Take Exit 97 to merge onto New Brunswick Route 1 W/NB W toward Lorneville/St. Stephenh – Take Exit 112 for NB-100 toward Lorneville – Turn left at the stop sign onto King William Rd/NB-100W. Continue driving 1.6 kms on King William Rd. until you get to the Lorneville Road – Turn left onto Lorneville Rd. (Welcome sign to Lorneville are by the exit). Drive another 1.6 kms then take a slight left. Field will be on the left.

**From East/Moncton/NS/PEI:** Stay on Hwy 1 W/NB-1W through Saint John – Take Exit 112 for NB-100 toward Lorneville – Turn left at the stop sign onto King William Rd/NB-100W – Continue drive 1.6 kms on King William Rd. until you get to the Lorneville Road. ### **Bulldog Club of Canada Regional Specialty Judge Bio – Mrs. Lee Steeves**

Lee has been involved with purebred dogs all of her life. While growing up, time was spent in her grandfather's Sporting Dog kennel. The English Springer Spaniels and Weimaraner were among her earliest friends and assisting a good dog man with his charges among her best memories of childhood.

A Beagle was her Mom's dog of choice and a cherished companion to all in the home until University called. On graduation, her Dad gifted her a Buick and a Great Dane (working through the Groups appeared to be a calling). In the family, there were also Miniature Schnauzers, Miniature Poodles and Airedales. It was to the latter that Lee gravitated as the breed to become the greatest part of her married life. Both Lee and her husband, Ken Curren, decided on the Airedale as a natural to form the basis of Regalridge – their highly successful breeding kennel. Regalridge later incorporated Welsh Terriers, Norwich and a collection of purebreds including Staffordshire Bull, Bull Terriers, Australian Terriers, Miniature Schnauzers, a Standard Smooth Dachshund and one much loved Cirneco D'el Etna. During her active show career, she also handled SCWT and campaigned Wire Fox. Many Regalridge Airedales and Welsh were among Canada's top terriers and number one in the breed. Wins were also had in the US including Specialties and Montgomery County KC class and breed wins with dogs bred and co-bred.

Judging has been a natural progression as we wound down the breeding program. As an all breed judge, Lee has judged in Scandinavia, the USA, Mexico and South America, Australia and throughout Canada including many National Specialties, Group Specialties and all breed assignments. Highlights of this judging included the Bulldog National in Australia and the Bulldog Supported entry in Mexico.

Serving on the Board of Directors of the Canadian Kennel Club for a dozen years, Lee was Chair of the Board as well as serving on many Committees and chairing the Task Force on Breed Specific Legislation. Her extensive professional credentials brought skills in Human Resources, Financial Management, Strategic Planning and Executive Operations to her dog related hobby.

It is a gift to be invited to adjudicate at shows; having the opportunity to assess breeds, talk dogs with like-minded acquaintances and to travel both within this wonderful country and beyond its borders is a genuine pleasure. I very much look forward to my upcoming assignments in New Brunswick knowing that our talented North American breeders and exhibitors will bring their best to this lovely venue.
