Entry Information

This is a **limited entry** trial. Entries will be accepted through DogShow.ca only.

If the limit is reached before the closing date, DogShow.ca will place you on a Waitlist according to when DogShow.ca received the entry.

Judging Schedules with the running orders and Armband Numbers will be sent out after the closing date. The judging schedule will also be available on www.canuckdogs.com.

No entry will be accepted that is incomplete or that is submitted without full entry fees. All entry fees must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary prior to closing date. Exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dog(s) regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The HKC reserves the right to refuse an entry, subject to CKC rules.

Personal Cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to the Halifax Kennel Club. No post-dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$40.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees.

All entries paid by credit card or E-transfer MUST be sent via DogShow.ca. No other entry service is authorized to accept entries for these events.



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. If you send a cheque in

US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we suggest that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds to the "Halifax Kennel Club". Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Eligibility

To compete in these trails, a dog must be at least 6 months of age and registered with the CKC and have a registration number, or an ERN, TCN, PEN, CCN or Misc. certificate number, or be eligible for the same. Dogs may not be lame.

Bitches in season are not permitted to enter the trials. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in the trial comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary before the starting date and the time of the trial.

No dog may be brought within the trial precincts if it is known to have a communicable disease or has recovered from a communicable disease within the last 30 (thirty) days prior to the event or has been housed within 30 (thirty) days with other dogs with a communicable disease. Entries may be refunded for dogs/bitches that pose a threat of communicable diseases on the day of the trial provided a letter from a veterinarian stating such is presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the commencement of the trial.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) will be eligible to apply for a TCN.

Temporary Competition (TC) fees of \$11.50 per trial are payable with the Entry Fee for dogs that do not have their individual registration number or ERN at the closing date. There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

NON-PUREBRED DOGS REQUIRE A CCN TO COMPLETE THEIR ENTRY:

These trials are open to non-purebred dogs. If entering your non-purebred dog (includes mixed-breed and unrecognized-breed) in these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number to complete the entry form. Event Registration Number (ERN):

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. **Effective January 1, 2023** the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. Canadian born dogs that are registerable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN. An ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event to avoid cancellation of any awards, scores or wins. Dogs may be entered as LISTED. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to CKC. An ERN may be obtained by contacting the CKC by phone at (416) 675-5511 or by fax (416) 675-6506.

Non-Member Participation Fee (Canadian residents):

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a “non-member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members. Rosettes and /or Prizes

Rosettes and/or prizes will be awarded for High in Class in Obedience and Rally Obedience. Rosette and/or prize will be awarded for Obedience High in Trial.

A HKC New Title Rosette will be available to those completing a title.

Change of Entry

Change of Entry are available provided the dog has completed the requirements for the level of competition, and has an individual CKC registration number, Change of Entry are available to the next level of competition at the next trial if made at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial by completing the required CKC Move-up Form.

Day of Entry

Day of Entry is permitted if the limit has not been reached for the second trial. Fee is \$35.00 for regular class. Fee is \$60.00 for RAE/RMX/OTCHX/MOTCH per dog. The entry must be completed and fee received 30 minutes before the trial starts.

Trial and General Information:

1. The **Trial Superintendent** will be in full charge of the events that will be governed by CKC rules.
2. **Trial Precincts:** The building and its entrances.
3. **Parking.** A designated parking area will be available at the venue.
4. **Crating.** Crating is available in an adjacent room to the Trial Room. There will be no ring-side crating.
5. All dogs must be under control on a leash at all times. Prong collars are not permitted on dogs within the trial precincts.
6. **Clean up** after your dog and don't let them potty on anything manmade.
7. Smoking or Vaping is not permitted in the building.
8. **Volunteers** are always needed to help the trials run on time and efficiently. Please contact the Trial Secretary if you are available to volunteer during the trial.
9. Exhibitors are responsible to be familiar with CKC Rules & Regulations for obedience and rally obedience trials.

11. The HKC will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
13. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the Trials, no refund of entries will be made.

Health Protocols

The Halifax Kennel Club will be following all Federal, provincial, and local health rules when holding the trials.
