Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds with a Canine Companion Number (CCN) are permitted to enter these trials.

Fee Structure

Entry Limit:

Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Pre-Entry) - \$35.00

Entry Fee for Second Class, Same Dog, Same Trial - \$25.00*

Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Day of Trial) - \$45.00

Listing Fee (TCN) per Dog per Class - \$11.50

Exhibition Only per Dog per Day - \$15.00

* This discount is for dogs who are entered in two classes in the same trial (Rally Advanced B & Excellent B, Rally Excellent B & Master, or Open B & Utility B Obedience only.) Pre-Entry only. Classes must be entered and paid for at the same time.

We currently have a rotation of veterinarians covering out of hours emergency care. Should you require emergency care please call [709-368-3728](tel:709-368-3728) and follow the prompts to be put in touch with the clinic on call.

There will be no refunds for withdrawn entries after the closing date except in the case of a female in season. When a female comes into season after entries have closed, she may be withdrawn from the trial and refunded provided the Trial Secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the female was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

Schedule of Events

Friday July 25th – Rally Trial 1, Rally Trial 2

Saturday July 26th – Obedience Trial 1, Rally Trial 3, & Rally Trial 4

Sunday July 27th – Obedience Trial 2, Rally Trial 5, & Rally Trial 6

Flat ribbons will be awarded for all Qualifying Scores, and rosettes will be awarded for all High in Class and Obedience High in Trial.

Prizes will be awarded to each Obedience High in Trial, and each unofficial Rally High in Trial (highest score from all classes with ties broken by time.)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Important Rules to Remember when Entering:

- To earn (most) Obedience or Rally titles, you must qualify three (3) times under at least two (2) different judges. We are offering six (6) Rally trials over the weekend, and you are welcome to enter all six, but be aware that whether your qualifying scores will count towards your title will depend on how many qualifying scores you have already earned under each judge for that title. If you are unsure about what you should enter, reach out to the trial secretaries.

- Not all dogs or handlers are eligible to enter all classes. Eligibility for the "A" Rally classes changed significantly in January 2024 and many handlers who were previously eligible to enter the "A" classes are no longer eligible to do so. Please check the rule book to ensure you and your dog are both eligible to enter the class you are planning to enter, and again, if you're unsure, reach out to the trial secretaries.

- There have been significant changes to the Pre-Novice, Novice, and Open Obedience classes effective January 2025. Please ensure that you have downloaded the most recent version of the rule book and reviewed the changes.

- All venues must permit the public, exhibitors and dogs entered in official and non-official classes at ring side. There shall not be any attempt to isolate the rings from onlookers or normal distractions. We will not be able to honour any requests to prevent spectators from standing ring side.

All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the trial site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the trial grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year.

There is absolutely no urinating allowed against the building, the steps, or the grass immediately next to the building and steps. Please move your dog away from the building before allowing them to potty. These are NADA's policies, and we must ensure they are followed if we wish to continue using this facility in the future.
