I have owned and bred a number of different breeds through the years, German Shepherds, Airedales, Siberian Huskies, Shibas, Border Collies, English Setters, Chinese Crested, I currently live with Shibas and a Powder Puff Chinese Crested. My first judging appointment was in 1976 and after moving to South Africa, I worked my way through the KUSA's Breed Judges Qualifying Scheme. I have also passed the UK Kennel Club's Conformation Exam. I am approved to judge All Breeds and Best in Show at Championship Show & FCI level.
