Ribbons and Rosettes:

Qualifying ribbons and new title rosettes will be available in the red shed.

Flat qualifying ribbons are awarded for all passes.

New title rosettes can be purchased for **\$10** including HST (cash only; please bring exact amount)

Please read the following rules:

Please bring a clean, dry pair of indoor shoes to trial in.

Please do not walk past the areas marked with caution tape and respect the pylons.

Dogs must always be on a leash.

No prong collars, choke chains, or e-collars on the property. Dogs must be on a flat collar, martingale collar, or flat harness only.

Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive. No nose to nose contact.

No smoking anywhere on the trial site.

Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.

Be kind to our judges and volunteers. Remember, if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.

Please do not walk your dogs toward the private residence at the front of the property.

Garbage policy: If you bring it, please take it home. There are dog waste bins available, but they cannot be used for anything else.

Please do not post on social media or discuss the search until the conclusion of each trial.

There are NO CREDITS nor refunds for anyone wishing to pull their entries after the closing date.

Lame dogs will be excused and entry fees will be refunded with a 30% processing fee deducted, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call. If dog is not present for assessment, a note signed by a veterinarian will be required for any refund or credit consideration.

Bitches in season must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties. The trial secretary must be notified as soon as possible if an entry has come into season.

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27 (aka Town Line Road). Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From CR 27 South: Follow CR 27 northbound through Thornton. Continue north. After 5 minutes, look for signs on your right that show you have to turn LEFT to stay on CR 27. When you see that sign, turn left continue on CR 27. When you come down the big hill look for our white flags on the west (left) side of the road. If you get to lights at Ardagh, you've gone too far

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee:

In 2010 the Board of Directors of the CKC passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting, the Tracking fee motion was deleted replaced with the following motion.

Non-Member Participation Fee:

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. This fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either, to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member Participation fee.

Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 9, 2025. Cost is \$170.00 + HST.

CKC Health Reminders:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.
4. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.
