In honor of a dear kind lady who was always generous with her help & knowledge and very patient with many of us as beginners. Helen was not new to raising dogs but new to Cairns in 1971. She was totally won over in no time & very convinced that all the Cairns really were "the best little pals in the world!" The picture of the Cairn on the trophy was Can.Am.Ch. MacSpacek Wee Bonni O'North, out of Helen's first litter (Ch. Cannycairns Fair Lady x Can.Am.Ch. Tycan's Ready-Or-Not). There were two in the litter & both became champions.

Barbara Hollings Memorial Trophy awarded to Best Puppy in Specialty

Barbara was a second generation Cairn breeder, becoming involved in her teenage years. She was an active member of The Cairn Terrier Club while in England. She moved to Canada in 1965 bringing Oona of Highhedges with her to continue with her breeding. She was one of the founding members of the CTCC. Many of the breeders today started with foundation stock from Barbara's "Highhedges" line.

Edna Perks Memorial Trophy awarded to Best of Winners

Edna purchased her first Caim from Helen Spacek, McSpacek Wee Bonnie O'North. She chose Cairnorth for her kennel name and later, Crofter together with Joan McMurphy. Edna joined the CTCC in 1975 and helped form the Alberta Clan in 1987, with the result of the first Alberta regional specialty in 1988. She became a life member of the CTCC in 2000. It was no surprise that Edna became a licensed permit judge in 1990 and an All-Breed judge in 2004. Edna came full circle when 20 years after forming the Alberta Clan she judged the 2008 CTCC Regional Specialty. She will be fondly remembered.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular</u> or <u>unofficial classes</u> or Parades

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

Attention Canadian Exhibitors!

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$59.40 + 5% GST.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require</u> an <u>ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is** \$59.40 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF OBTAINING POINTS, AWARDS OR SCORES. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.</u>
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
 All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor
 passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact
 the Show Secretary.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an *Event Registration Number* or a *Miscellaneous Certification Number*.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
