

<u>From the 400:</u> Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Novice C - This class is for dogs that have attained the Companion Dog or ANY other obedience title.
