Instinct, Novice – Container, Interior, Exterior; Open – Container, Interior, Exterior; Excellent – Container, Interior, Exterior Master – Container, Interior, Exterior includes, Entry Limit – 90 Runs (Maximum 25 Instinct Tests)

#### **ROSETTES**

A Rosette will be awarded to all Novice, Open, Excellent and Master new titles. Only those dogs earning qualifying scores will receive ribbons (flat) A suitable Rosette will be provided to dogs earning their Instinct Test.

- 1. One dog per handler per division.
- 2. The CDC respectfully asks that no posting of testing be placed on social media until end of trial.
- 3. The only dog permitted in trial area is dog being tested; no dogs allowed with spectators.
- 4. No Prong Collars.
- 5. No internal kenneling. All dogs must be under control on a leash except during the test.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

All entry fees must be in the hands of our Show Secretary prior to closing date.

Personal cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to the **COBEQUID DOG CLUB.** No post-dated cheques accepted.

All NSF cheques and declined credit cards will be subject to a charge of \$40.00.

N.S.F. cheques are considered non -payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the trial.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows and Trials are available from the Canadian Kennel Club or On Line. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

## **IMPORTANT**



To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the trial secretaries after the closing time and date. *Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes* It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of

receipt by recipients. **NOTE:** All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via The Entry Line. The Cobequid Dog Club **does not** accept credit cards for payment.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

The Dog Show Rules states a judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out.

A copy of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows & Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club regarding their events.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (Conformation Show Rules Sec. 19.7)
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the PCKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows, no refund of entry fees will be made
- Only dogs entered in the Show will be permitted on the show premises.
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the
  progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that
  this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.1.3)
- No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.6)

#### ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non -Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles.
