Rules A copy of the rules pertaining to Obedience and Rally Obedience trials may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

NON-PUREBRED DOGS IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS

Non-purebred dogs will be accepted in both Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials. If entering your non-purebred dog in either of these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number. Please check the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.31 (found online at the CKC website) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$58.50 (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.

4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / Mastercard number, expiry date, cardholder's name, and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show/Test/Trial Superintendent will be in full charge of the event that will be governed by CKC rules.
2. The NSGSDC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
3. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
4. There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments. Entries will be refunded where Bitches are unable to compete in Obedience due to heats. Veterinary certificate must be provided to the Trial Secretary to apply for refund.
5. Judging schedules are broken down and based on 8 Novice dogs per hour, 7 Open dogs per hour, and 5 Utility dogs per hour, rally obedience, maximum of 15 per hour. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. There will be no waiting for dogs.
6. All exhibitors will be responsible for clean up on the premise and surrounding areas for their own dogs and/or dogs they are handling.
7. The precincts of the trials will be the building and its entrances.
8. A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 4.7.1)
9. Incomplete entries will be returned for correction. Please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in and to who ID's are to be returned.
10. No person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 4.1.5)

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles.
