#### PAYMENT:

- **Entries not accompanied by payment (cheque or e-Transfer) will NOT be accepted**
- **Entry fees may be paid by e-Transfer sent to email address – [treasurer.eorc@gmail.com](mailto:treasurer.eorc@gmail.com)**
- Make cheques payable to the Eastern Ontario Retriever Club (EORC), dated no later than Sunday, May 15, 2022
- A \$11.30 listing fee (\$10.00+HST) must be included for dogs without a CKC registration number or ERN or TCN
- Separate entry forms must be completed for each stake into which the dog is entered.
- Scratches/refunds for dogs withdrawn after the closing date, for reasons other than stated in the CKC Retriever Field Trial rule book, will not have their entry fees refunded
- All fees to be in Canadian funds, no exchange will be given on U.S. funds.
- Effective 2018, the NRCC is taking a proactive role to ensure future funding for National events. In response to the majority vote taken in the 2017 Survey to Examine National Events in Canada, the NRCC is asking member clubs to collect \$5.00 per dog competing in each All Age Stake held. \*\*Note that the entry fees listed for Open and Amateur **includes** the \$5.00 fee. At the end of the trial season, 100% of the funds collected will be distributed retroactively to the National Host Club(s) for that year.

**RUNNING ORDER:** The starting dog in the first series of Open and Amateur will be determined by using the last two digits at closing of the Toronto Stock Exchange (TSE) S&P/TSX composite index on the Thursday immediately preceding the trial. At the Judge's discretion, there will be a rotation of running order in all of the stakes.

**GAME:** Dead ducks and/or pheasants will be used in all stakes

**POINTS and RIBBONS:**

- Placings and points awarded are as follows: First-5, Second-3, Third-2, Fourth-1
- Standard CKC rosettes to the first four placings and certificates of merit (CM) in each stake

**DIRECTIONS:**

From 401 at Exit 705. Take Exit 705 off the 401. Head northwest toward Concession 2 Rd. Turn right onto Concession 2 Rd (signs for County Road 15/Maitland Road). Turn left at the 1st cross street onto County Rd 15 (signs for County Road 15 N/Maitland). Turn right onto Carleys Corners Rd. Destination will be on the right.

**RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS AND THE EASTERN ONTARIO RETRIEVER CLUB:**

By entering this event, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the event and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of the property upon which the event is held, together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person, dog, or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant and all of his heirs, executors and assigns.

**CAUTION:** The Eastern Ontario Retriever Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any dog or to any equipment whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore, The Eastern Ontario Retriever Club will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to participants, bystanders, club members, workers or any other individual using any of the properties for any purpose.

Field Trial Officials will be enforcing COVID -19 related guidelines whenever possible, however, The Eastern Ontario Retriever Club will not be held responsible for transmission of the novel coronavirus (SARS-CoV2) or any related illness due to Covid-19.

**ATTENTION:** Please read and familiarize yourself with the following COVID-19 guidelines. The Eastern Ontario Retriever Club will assume that by submitting your entry that you accept and will abide by all Ontario Provincial recommendations with regards to COVID-19. These guidelines may be amended or altered by the Club as required.

1. Club officials and participants are required to follow all guidelines that apply.
2. Practice social distancing. Avoid congregating in groups as much as possible. Gallery must practice social distancing - 6 feet or 2 metres between chairs.
3. Avoid shaking hands and hugging.
4. Avoid touching dogs or equipment that does not belong to you or is not your responsibility.
5. Park with sufficient distance between vehicles.
6. Follow the marshals instructions regarding running order and entering holding blinds.
7. Any special instructions from the judges will be posted in the holding blind.
8. Handlers will be invited to the line in small groups. You might not see the test dog run but will have the opportunity to see other dogs run from the holding blinds.
9. Birds will be placed into a bucket or onto bird rack by the handler and dealt with by the marshal once the dog and handler leave the line. Follow the instructions from the marshal.
10. Hand sanitizer will be available.
11. Have fun, stay safe.

- Please note new CKC Ruling: Canadian Resident non CKC Members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member fee to the CKC otherwise, awards & titles will be cancelled.
- Field Trial Rule 21.7: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred".
- The Eastern Ontario Retriever Club is a member of the National Retriever Club of Canada. Dogs entered in all age stakes may qualify for the National Stakes.
