CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

BABY PUPPY shall be for dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. **These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points. Judging will be After Best of Breed judging, After Group judging and BEFORE BIS judging.**

JUNIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: shall be for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12-18 MONTHS - for dogs over 12 months of age but under 18 months of age.

CANADIAN BRED: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country excluded

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN: shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

VETERANS: For all dogs 7 years and over on the day of the show. They compete for regular placement and the winners to on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

EXHIBITION ONLY: Dogs in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this Premium List.

EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MOS.): Is for dogs 3 mos. of age and under 6 mos. on the day of the show, providing the owner has entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. These puppies may not compete in any official, unofficial, non-regular classes or Parades.

BRACE: Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex or owned by the same person)

SIRE & GET: Entry into this class shall comprise the Sire and two or more of his Get (Note: Get MUST be entered in a regular class, Sire must be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only)

DAM & PROGENY: Shall have all the same requirements as the Sire & Get Class

SEXUALLY ALTERED: Eligibility into this class shall be limited to dogs over six months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class WILL be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

FIELD DOG: For all German Shorthaired Pointers who have earned any placement in an official class at a Licensed Field Trial or have earned a qualifying score in a Field Dog test in Canada or who have received an AFTCH, FTCH, FDJ, FD, FDA or FDX under the rules of the Canadian Kennel Club by the close of entries. Each dog must also be entered in a Regular Class or for Exhibition Only.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) **"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"**

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

Listing fees are required for any dog without an individual CKC/ERN Registration number. The owner(s) must then submit an application for registration to the CKC within thirty (30) days. Failure to comply with these rulings will automatically cancel all points on record.

Please use the official entry form enclosed.

Cheques post-dated to closing date WILL be accepted. Any NSF cheques will be assessed a \$25 service charge. Tendering a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards (Chapter 8.8.2 CKC Dog Show Rules).

No entry will be accepted without payment in full. There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

The owner of the dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of their dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

Withdrawal of entries prior to closing may be made by telephone, but **MUST BE FOLLOWED UP IN WRITING**, and be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing. If written, or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

In the event of a postal strike: Telephone entries may be made in accordance with the CKC Dog Show Rules. 1.877.203.0363 (collect calls will not be accepted). All phoned entries must be signed and entry fees paid in cash, money-order, or certified cheque before the dog may enter the ring. No refunds after closing date.

To comply with instructions issued by the CKC, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in mail. **We suggest mail by special delivery/hand delivery, not registered mail.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

Dog Show Rule Books and Obedience Trial Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. In Canada call toll free 1-800-250-8040, in the United States call 1-416-675-5511. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules. Entries will be acknowledged after close of entries with receipt and judging schedule. This Show will be open from 7:00 AM until completion of judging. Dogs must be on the show grounds one hour before the judging of their class. Judging will not commence before 8:00 AM.

Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The starting time for each ring will be specified in the Judging Schedule.

PLEASE NOTE: You are responsible for cleaning up if your dog relieves itself.

The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons, or property.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: (Chapter 4, Section 4.1.3 of CKC Dog Show Rules) "A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season, after the entry of the bitch has been submitted, if a Veterinarian certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial) to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded after the closing date. Nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the EKKOC it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs and children must be kept under control as a courtesy to fellow exhibitors and spectators.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors!

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **ERN- Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **ERN must be applied for within 30 days of first day of entering a CKC EVENT**. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- *To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however, as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.*
- *Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.*

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

Overpayment and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you.
