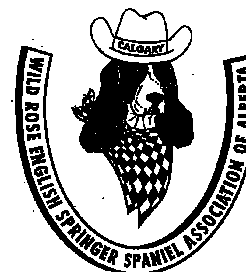

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number **but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number**. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost per copy is \$6.30.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7.

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone **but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time**. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades</u>

NON-REGULAR, UNOFFICIAL CLASSES & PARADES (dogs must be entered in a regular class or for exhibition only.)

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered. PLEASE FILL OUT 'EXTRA FORM' IN THIS PREMIUM LIST.
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and all Get must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Brood Bitch and all Progeny must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.
TEAM	The requirements for this class are the same as Brace except that 4 dogs must be entered.. PLEASE FILL OUT 'EXTRA FORM' IN THIS PREMIUM LIST.
GENERATIONAL	This class is open to groups of 3 or more dogs representing 3 or more direct / consecutive generations which will be judged as a group. (Ex. -1) Grandsire or granddam, 2) son or daughter, 3) grandson or granddaughter. The individual dogs need not be of the same sex. The individual dogs need not have the same owner. Each dog must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. PLEASE FILL OUT 'EXTRA FORM' IN THIS PREMIUM LIST.
GUN DOG	for any dog of either sex that has attained at least one leg on any CKC or AKC recognized hunting title or an ESSFTA Working Dog (WD or WDX) title by the close of entries and may be spayed or neutered.
PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS	Open to dogs that have any CKC recognized title. Please supply a short biography of 50 words or less for each dog entered in the Parade. This should be provided with the entry at the time of entry closing.
PARADE OF VETERANS	for any dog 7 years of age or older. Please supply a short biography of 50 words or less for each dog entered in the Parade. This should be provided with the entry at time entries closing.

Regular Obedience Classes

Novice A for any purebred dog that has not earned the title of CD. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Novice B for any purebred dog that has not earned the title of CD in CANADA.. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class.

Open A for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CD but has not won the title of CDX. Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously handled a dog through its UD title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is not eligible for entry in this class.

Open B for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CD, CDX or UD in CANADA. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the 'sit' and 'down' exercise. A dog which has won a comparable degree in any foreign country is eligible for this class. NO dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at any one trial.

Utility for any purebred dog that has earned the title of CDX in CANADA.

Transition Obedience Classes

Pre-Novice for any purebred dog that has not earned the title PCD (Pre Companion Dog) title in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in group exercise. A dog may be entered in this class that has not earned the title of CD in Canada or US. The Pre Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to Novice Classes. The CKC will permit the use of PCD signifying Pre Companion Dog to be used in connection with and after the name of the dog. In order to receive this title dogs must receive passing scores in three different trials under two different judges.

Unofficial Obedience Classes

Veterans Class for any purebred dog that has an obedience title and is 7 years of age or older on the day of the trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in this Class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

Brace Two dogs which have earned at least a Canadian CD title. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs entered in this Class must also be entered in any Regular class or for Exhibition Only.
