GENERAL INFORMATION

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC and infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report that this has occurred.



ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE:

To be eligible to compete in this Match, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible to be registered with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, CCN, Eligible for registration with the CKC, or a CKC Misc. Cert number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed. A dog may be spayed, neutered, or debarked. Dogs must not be lame or must not compete if tape or bandages may impair its working ability. Dogs with physical challenges are eligible to compete, if in the opinion of the judge they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. No dog may be entered at a trial if it has any communicable disease. Dogs entered in a test must have current immunization status.

Minors under the age of 16 are not permitted to enter/handle dogs at these trials. A parent or guardian signature and accompaniment is required for permitted minors under the age of 18.

BITCHES IN SEASON:

Bitches in season are permitted to compete. They must be run at the end of the run order for each class and must wear clean, properly fitted panties.

When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the owner of the dog must inform the host club

CKC Rules regarding Collars, Leashes & Harnesses (51-05-20) 9.4.1

Dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. The harness will be constructed of plain, pliable material and will be designed so that there is minimal restriction of the dog's movement. No special training tools, such as electronic collars, prong collars, head halters, choke chains, or no-pull harnesses may be used during the search. Martingale collars are permitted. No odor emitting collars (such as no-bark collars that spray citronella, or DAP calming collars) may be worn or present in the scent area.

CKC Rules regarding Health

6.6.1 No dog may be entered at a trial if it has any communicable disease.

6.6.2 Dogs entered in a test must have current immunization status.

6.6.3 No dog may be brought onto the grounds or

premises of a trial if it:

- (a) Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease, or
- (b) Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable within the last 30 days.



(c) Has been housed within 30 days prior to the trial on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

6.6.4 Where it is found that these rules have been contravened, the dog in question shall be removed from the premises and the exhibitor/handler will be subject to disciplinary action.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

- Handlers will be charged for any damage done to equipment or facility by dogs (including urinating on items thus rendering them unusable).
- **PROOF OF A CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION IS REQUIRED FOR ALL DOGS ENTERING IN THE TRIALS. A COPY MUST BE SCANNED TO THE EVENT SECRETARY PRIOR TO YOUR ENTRY BEING APPROVED. If you previously submitted for the TRIAL OCTOBER 2024 and it has not expired, then you need not resubmit.**
- No second dogs will be permitted in the same class.
- All dogs must be leashed at all times on the property.
- Reminder that anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors as both the speaker & the listener will be excused.
- No spectators will be allowed in the trial search areas.
- There can be no training or non-official use of odour on trial grounds.
- There is a zero tolerance for unruly or disrespectful behaviour. Anyone exhibiting these actions will be removed from the property.

Attention Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. For the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice of either be-coming a CKC member or paying the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within thirty (30) days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up. For a membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms on-line. The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January-December) in which the dog earned its title.
