Fun! Fast! Exciting! Agility is a fun dog sport where you handle and race with your dog through different obstacles like tunnels, jumps, teeter totters, ramps and more! This event is a “Just For Fun” competition for people and their dogs who would like to participate in a friendly and fun Agility match. Participants & dogs must have taken at least one Agility class. If you have not done Agility with your dog before, please call us for more information before registering.

Fun Match Package includes 5 starter/advanced level events: 1 Gambler, 1 Standard, 1 Snooker, 2 Jumpers. Ribbons will be given for 1st to 3rd place in each category. There will be special prizes for top scores & more! Entry fee includes tea/hot chocolate/coffee in the morning, and a pizza lunch with dessert and beverages. Please note, event participants will be asked to volunteer as “ring crew”.

Gamblers: Consists of two distinct parts. In the first part, the dogs earns points for each obstacle performed correctly (each obstacle may be performed twice successfully). After the whistle blows, the dog can earn bonus points by working away from the handler through a series of obstacles, while the handler stands behind a designated line.

Standard: Includes all obstacles and obstacles must be performed in order and in the time set by the judge.

Jumpers/Steeplechase: Jumpers is a numbered course consisting of only jumps and tunnels. Steeplechase is a numbered course consisting of jumps, tunnels, a-frame and weaves only.

Snooker: Two part course, opening consists of 3-4 red jump and obstacle combos, closing is numbered sequence of obstacles, 60 seconds.

Please review the following Fun Match Policy, Terms and Conditions and indicate your understanding and acceptance by signing below.

CLOSING DATE | Registration closes on SEPTEMBER 30th, 2013 or when the event is full. Please register prior to the closing date.

SCHEDULE | 8:00 am to 4:00pm. Registration begins at 8:00 am. Familiarization at 8:15 am. First dog on the line at 9:00 am. Please make sure to arrive no later than 8:00 am.

TOYS, TREATS & CLICKERS | THIS IS A FUN MATCH! Toys, treats, clickers, and collars/leashes are all permitted on course. Dogs may compete On-leash (for exhibition only). Use of food and toys are allowed in ring.

LIABILITY WAIVER | Registrants and their guests are required to sign a liability waiver form upon arrival at the event. Please arrive promptly at 8:00 am in order to complete the necessary paperwork. Registrants and guests are unable to observe or participate in the event if these forms have not been completed. Refunds will not be issued if a participant misses any portion of the event for this reason. Parent/guardians are required to be present to sign on behalf of any minors under 18 years of age and accompany their child for the duration of the event. Only legal guardians are permitted to complete required paperwork.

SITE ETIQUETTE & WHAT TO BRING | All competitors are required to clean up after their dog. Anyone failing to do so, will be dismissed from the event with no refund. When not competing, dogs are required to be on-leash—a crate or expen is recommended. There will be a crating area provided. Car crating will depend on weather (heat). Bring your own chair, please. Dress warm, the barn is not heated.

LOST OR STOLEN PROPERTY | DOGSmart Training is not responsible for lost or stolen property. Participants should not bring any valuables with them to the event. Participants and guests should ensure that they have all of their belongings with them before leaving the event. Any lost articles not claimed within 30 days of the event will be donated to charity.

SAFETY & COMFORT | DOGSmart Training strives to create a safe and fun environment for all its clients, guests and event participants. As such, DOGSmart Training reserves the right to dismiss any participant from the event for any reason that it believes compromises the safety, comfort and/or enjoyment of other program participants. This includes but is not limited to; participant's inappropriate or aggressive behaviour or language towards their dog, staff, instructors or other participants. Refunds are not provided in these circumstances.

PHOTO RELEASE | DOGSmart Training takes photos of its events and its participants to share all of the fun and excitement that happens! DOGSmart Training may use photos for promotional purposes including its website and social media. By registering for an event or program at DOGSmart Training, you agree to photos being taken of yourself and your dog, and will need to sign a photo release form upon arrival. If you would prefer not to have photos taken, please inform the DOGSmart staff prior to the start of the event.

DOG REQUIREMENTS | All dogs must be 9 months of age or older with two sets of vaccinations in order to attend the program. Bandanas to be worn for the day will be provided to dogs with "space issues" (reactive to other dogs) so others will be aware to not crowd them. Should a participant's dog be deemed aggressive, reactive or unsuitable to attend the event for any other reason, DOGSmart reserves the right to dismiss the participant and their dog from the event. Refunds are not provided in these circumstances, however may be considered in special circumstances where a dog is unable to participate and is at the discretion of the event's manager. Participants are required to inform DOGSmart Training of any important medical conditions or allergies that their dog has. Dogs must be in good health in order to attend the event. Please call us for more information prior to registering if you are unsure about whether or not your dog is able to attend, or if you would like more information.

DOG LEASHES & COLLARS | Please equip your dog with a flat buckle collar, front clip harness, or head-halter only for all classes and events. All other types of collars including pinch, choke, martingale and shock collars, as well as retractable-leashes are not permitted.

CANCELLATION & REFUNDS | Cancellations must be received no later than 14 days prior to the date of the event. We are unable to issue refunds for cancellations received less than 14 days prior to the event date. Due to the nature of Fun Match events, we are unable to provide any refunds (full or partial) for any reason other than injuries or bitches in season.

PAYMENT | Payment of \$56 plus GST (\$58.80) must be submitted with this registration form in order to be accepted. Registrations without payment in full will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted.
